

# FLAT PACK FIRE PIT INSTRUCTIONS



UNIQUE HAND-FORGED BRITISH MADE FIRE PITs

**CAUTION: The Flat Pack Fire Pit gets hot when lit, and will retain its heat even after the fire is out. Do not touch without heat resistant gloves when it's hot and wait until it's cooled to pack away. The area under the fire pit may scorch, so please place it on a fire resistant surface.**

## Assembling your Flat Pack Fire Pit

Your Flat Pack Fire Pit consists of two long side pieces, two short side pieces, a bottom grate and a top grill.

Prop up the two short sides and line up the slots with one long side. Slide together. Take the second long side, and slide into place. Slot the grate into one long side first, and then drop into place by slightly lifting the second long side.

The grill can be popped on top when you're ready to sizzle those sausages or boil the kettle.

To pack away, wait until the steel has completely cooled, then simply slide one long side out and then the other.

## Good to Know

Before lighting your fire, make sure it is placed on a heat resistant surface, such as a grassy area or stone patio. The Flat Pack Fire Pit is relatively low to the ground so can cause scorching directly beneath the fire.

Once assembled, pick up by the short sides to move around.

Over time, steel will oxidise and develop an even rusty patina. This does not affect the longevity or durability of the fire pit. If you like, you can clean it up with a wire brush and rub over some oil.
