

FLAT TABLE TOP LID INSTRUCTIONS

UNIQUE HAND-FORGED BRITISH MADE FIRE PITS

CAUTION: The steel of the fire pit and lid will get hot – do not touch without heat resistant gloves

The Flat Table Top Lid is a multi-tasking extra that you will not want to be without. When it arrives, it will be coated in manufacturing oil, but don't worry as this will burn off with your first fire.

To use as a snuffer

1. You can keep your fire burning right up until you are ready to go indoors. Place the lid on top of the fire pit to snuff out the fire. Leave the lid in place and smoke will billow from under the lid as shown in the image over the page. This is quite normal.
2. Leave the lid in place and go indoors, secure in the knowledge that no hot embers will blow around in your absence. The manufacturing oil will burn off during this process.
3. The lid can remain in situ until the next time you want to use the fire pit. The lid will keep out any water and debris so the fire bowl will be nice and dry when you next come to use the fire pit. At this time, simply remove the lid and light a new fire.

To use as a table top

1. When not using your fire pit, you can use the lid as a table top to sit around with drinks or use for decorative purposes by placing a plant on top.
2. Please ensure that the lid has sufficiently cooled from the previous fire before using as a table top.

Your fire pit and lid are designed to live outdoors all year round and over time it will develop its own natural patina. If you wish to you can rub over with a wire brush and then oil. However, it is fine to leave them outside and allow them to take their natural course. Please be aware that as the fire pits will oxidise, rust can mark stone terraces and paving slabs. If placed on a lawn, the heat from the fire may scorch the grass underneath.
